



Denison Road Underpass Construction

The Georgetown South Project will provide infrastructure improvements to meet existing GO Transit ridership demand and future growth. It will also accommodate the new Air Rail Link service between Union Station and Pearson International Airport.

What Are We Doing?

Denison Road will become an underpass. Denison Road will be re-aligned to the north, creating cul-de-sacs of the existing Denison Road to the west of the rail tracks and at Sam Frustaglio Drive. A turn-around will be created on Arthur Street with the closure of the laneway.

Before the underpass construction can begin, we first have to relocate utilities such as hydro and telecommunications that cross the rail corridor. The main construction will begin in the early spring, after the utility relocation is complete. The Denison Road Underpass is scheduled to be completed in late spring 2013.

Why Are We Doing It?

With the expansion of rail service, it is unsafe to keep a level rail crossing. As outlined in the approved Environmental Assessment, GO Transit will be separating rail traffic from car/pedestrian/bicycle traffic with the construction of the Denison Road Underpass.

What's Happening Now?

On Tuesday, January 4, 2011, our contractors, Dufferin Construction Company, moved onto site and have set up their trailers at the former Price Chopper property at 1731 Weston Road. The utility relocation work is scheduled to begin on Monday, January 17. The work will be focused on the west side of the tracks near Denison Road.

How Will This Impact You?

Standard equipment used during the utility relocation includes a back hoe and hydro vacuum. This work will create normal construction noise. Work will take place during regular construction hours from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. weekdays; however, if necessary, work outside these hours will be communicated in advance.
