PASSENGER RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Passenger Rules and Regulations are prepared for the guidance and convenience of passengers. Please refer to Metrolinx's By-Laws for legal requirements regarding the use of the GO system, as well as to laws of general application, such as the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Criminal Code.

1. APPLICATION AND DEFINITION OF FARES

Except as otherwise provided, the fares set out in the Tariff of Fares in Section D of these Passenger Rules and Regulations (the "Tariff of Fares") shall be paid for passage on GO Transit services and no other reduction in fare shall be granted to any class of passenger. Detailed fares between all stations or zones are shown in the Fare Zone Charts included in Section B of these Passenger Rules and Regulations (the "Fare Zone Charts") and are payable in Canadian or U.S. Funds. All fares set out in the Fare Zone Charts and Tariff of Fares include all applicable taxes.

Note: Wherever the word "Ticket" is used it includes a paper ticket, a pass or other fare media (such as a PRESTO card) issued by GO Transit.

Wherever the words "Proper Authority" are used, they include any employee of Metrolinx (the "Corporation") carrying an identification card issued by the Corporation.

1.1 - The following fare categories are available subject to specified restrictions:

1.1.1 - Adult - An Adult Fare shall be tendered by all passengers thirteen (13) years of age and over who do not otherwise qualify for the special discounted fares outlined herein.

1.1.2 - Child - A Child Fare (Half-Fare) shall be tendered by passengers under thirteen (13) years of age but over six (6) years of age (a "Child"). See "Child Fares" below regarding the carriage of children less than six years.

1.1.3 - Student - A student (a "Student") means a person living in an area served by a transit system who is:

1.1.3.1 - thirteen (13) years of age or more but not yet twenty (20) years of age and in full daytime attendance at a public or private elementary or secondary school; or

1.1.3.2 - in full daytime attendance for a minimum of eight consecutive weeks and not earning a salary from full-time employment while attending:

1.1.3.2.1 - a post-secondary educational institution; or

1.1.3.2.2 - a post-secondary vocational institution that is either public or registered under the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* S.O. 2005, Chapter 28.

1.1.4 - Senior Citizen - A Senior Citizen Fare (Half-Fare) shall be tendered by those persons 65 years of age and over (each, a "Senior Citizen"). See Senior Citizen Fares regarding rules of acceptance for Senior Citizen Fares.

1.1.5 - Under certain circumstances due to arrangements and agreements with Municipalities or other carriers these Rules and Regulations may be modified.

1.2 - Except for special fares provided in the Tariff of Fares or as published in bulletins or supplements or posted on the Corporation's public website (www.gotransit.com) from time to time, fares between all zones set out in the Fare Zone Charts shall be paid for a single one-way ride and no other reduction in fare shall be granted to any class of passenger.

1.3 - Adult Fares are shown in the Tariff of Fares as single one-way fares.

Bus Drivers sell only Adult, Half-Fare Single, Day Pass Tickets and Group Passes. Other ticket forms are available at most stations, terminals and agencies.

1.4 - A single ticket will be accepted on GO Transit services for transportation for one trip from the originating zone to the destination zone as marked on the ticket and the trip must commence within four hours of issuance.

1.5 - Passes may be accepted on GO Transit services for passage to any destination that is within the period printed or encoded on the pass and is not beyond the destination printed or encoded on the pass.

1.6 - Fares from or to intermediate points not specifically shown herein will be the same as the fare from or to the next more distant point.

1.7 - A person tendering the fare shall pay for that fare with the exact cash amount indicated in the Tariff of Fares or ticket of equal value. If a ticket of equal value has not been purchased a fare of exact cash shown in the Tariff of Fares must be tendered.

1.8 - No person shall travel on GO Transit services without a valid ticket issued by, and acceptable to, GO Transit. "Valid" means, a single ride that is used within four hours of issuance; or a period pass, whether in paper or electronic form, for transportation.

1.8.1 - No fare is required to be paid by a police officer as defined in Section 2 of the Police Services Act (Ontario) or a police officer of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police who is in possession of the official identification issued by the police services engaging such officer. For greater certainty, the benefit of this provision does not extend to any Special Constable, First Nations Constable, By-law Enforcement Officer, or any auxiliary or civilian member of a police force.

1.8.2 - On days that are for National or Provincial recognition of war veterans, no fare is required to be paid by:

- (i) a war veteran and any person accompanying him or her; or
- (ii) the immediate family of a deceased veteran, provided the individual can provide identification or service papers to prove the relation to the deceased veteran.

1.9 - Two Senior Citizens, two Children under thirteen (13) years of age or a Senior Citizen and one Child under thirteen (13) years of age may ride on a valid Adult Single-Ride Ticket or a valid Adult Day Pass.

1.10 - A ticket issued by GO Transit is valid only for continuous passage without a stop-over on a train or bus scheduled to stop at the destination printed, marked, or encoded on the ticket.

2. ADULT FARES

Adult Fares are shown in the Fare Zone Charts and the Tariff of Fares as single one-way fare (shown in dollars and cents) and any reductions applicable to these fares are available on the Corporation's public website at www.gotransit.com.

2.1 - Day Pass

A Day Pass:

2.1.1 - shall be sold at a rate of two times the fare that would be payable by an adult for a single one-way fare;

2.1.2 - shall be valid from 3:00 am on the date of issue for an unlimited number of rides on the transit system between the zones in the transit corridor for which the pass is issued, where the value of the pass is equal or greater, until 3:00 am on the day after the date of issue;

2.1.3 - is not transferable;

2.1.4 - must be retained and produced for inspection; and

2.1.5. - is not refundable.

3. CHILD FARES

3.1 - Except as provided in Subsection 3.4 and 3.6, the fares to be paid for a Child less than thirteen (13) years of age but more than six (6) years of age shall be the half fare of the Adult Fare.

3.2 - No fare shall be payable for one child, who has not reached his or her sixth birthday (such child, a "Minor").

3.3 - A Minor must be accompanied by an adult passenger.

3.4 - An adult passenger accompanied by more than one Minor (excluding infants under the age of 12 months) shall pay, in addition to his or her own fare, the fare prescribed by Subsection 3.1, for each additional Minor.

3.5 - Any person thirteen (13) years of age or over shall pay the fare applicable to adult passengers except as otherwise provided.

3.6 - Where more than one Child is travelling, refer to Section 1.9 which may apply.

3.7 - Day Pass

A Day Pass:

3.7.1 - shall be sold at a rate of two times the fare that would be payable by a Child for a single one-way fare;

3.7.2 - shall be valid from 3:00 am on the date of issue for an unlimited number of rides on the transit system between the zones in the transit corridor for which the pass is issued, where the value of the pass is equal or greater, until 3:00 am on the day after the date of issue;

3.7.3 - is not transferable;

3.7.4 - must be retained and produced for inspection; and

3.7.5 - is not refundable.

4. STUDENT FARES

Students as defined in Subsection 1.1.3 of these Rules and Conditions will be eligible to travel at a reduced rate, provided the Student is in possession of one of the acceptable forms of a Student identification card (Student ID card) as described below in Section 4.1. Students must carry their Student ID card at all times while travelling on the GO Transit system.

4.1 - Student Identification Card

4.1.1 - Elementary, Junior and Secondary Schools: Students ages 13-19 years of age and attending Canadian public or private elementary, junior or secondary schools with a valid school-issued photo Student ID card can use this card while travelling on the GO Transit system. A Student attending elementary, junior or secondary school will cease to be eligible for the Student Fare discount on the Student's 20th birthday. If the Student attends an elementary, junior or secondary school that does not issue Student ID card, the Student must obtain a GO Transit Student ID Card as described in Section 4.1.3.

4.1.2 - Post-Secondary Schools: Students in full-time attendance at Canadian post-secondary schools may use a valid school-issued photo Student ID card provided it meets the following requirements:

- issued by a Canadian college or university, including career colleges registered under the Private Career Colleges Act (excluding online courses/institutions);

- issued annually;
- indicates an expiry date of the current academic year (note that Students in full-time attendance at post-secondary schools can use their Student ID card until October 31st of the expiration year (i.e. if the Student ID card expires in June 2013, it would be valid for use on the GO Transit system until October 31, 2013)); and
- indicates the full-time status of the Student.

If the Student attends a post-secondary school that does not issue Student ID card that meets the above criteria, the Student must obtain a GO Transit Student ID Card as described in Section 4.1.2 and 4.1.3. Note: Students attending a post-secondary institution other than college and/or university (e.g. trade/vocational school) for 8 weeks or more may also apply for a GO Transit Student ID Card as described in Section 4.1.2 and 4.1.3 by providing proof of admission which indicates the length of the course/program (in this case, the Student ID Card would expire at the end of the course/program).

4.1.2.1 - Post-Secondary School-Issued GO Transit Student ID Cards or Validation Stickers.

Certain post-secondary schools are authorized to issue GO Transit Student ID Cards or Validation Stickers that can be placed on school-issued Student ID cards. School-issued GO Transit Student ID Cards or Validation stickers entitle the Student to the Student fare discount. Students should consult GO Transit's website at www.gotransit.com for an updated list of participating schools and visit their school's website for more details on the application process.

4.1.3 - GO Transit Student ID Card: Students may apply for a GO Transit Student ID Card using GO's manual application form available either from the Student's educational institution or Union Station. The completed application form must be signed by the Registrar or other appointed official of the eligible educational institution attended and then submitted to Union Station at the address listed below in one of three ways:

1. Take the signed form to Union Station where a card will be issued on the spot.
2. Take the signed form to any GO Train station. It will be sent to Union Station to be processed, and then returned for pick-up at the station of the Student's choice. (Please allow 2-4 weeks for processing.)
3. Mail the signed form, along with a self-addressed, stamped return envelope to:

Upon receipt and acceptance, GO Transit will provide the Student with a GO Transit Student ID Card. Applications will be processed during the following hours: weekdays 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m., and weekends 10:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

4.1.3.1 - GO Transit Student ID Cards are subject to the following terms and conditions. The GO Transit Student ID Card remains the property of GO Transit and must not be altered, recreated or changed. The GO Transit Student ID Card is subject to confiscation if the holder fails to follow the terms and conditions described herein. A new application must be submitted in advance of each registration period or school year. GO Transit Student ID

Cards are non-transferable and are valid only for the personal use of the Student whose signature appears thereon. Students may be asked by a Proper Authority to show their Student ID Card. Therefore, Students must carry their Student ID Card at all times while travelling on the GO Transit system in order for their ticket to be valid.

4.2 - Student using a fare media card such as PRESTO must register their PRESTO cards to have them set up for the Student fare. For post-secondary students, the post-secondary student classification must be added to the PRESTO card each school year. See the GO Transit website at www.gotransit.com for more details.

4.3 - Students who leave the educational institution during any part of the academic year will cease to be eligible for the Student fare discount.

4.4 - GO Transit reserves the right to cancel the GO Transit Student ID Card and any associated fare media should the Student wilfully cause damage to property owned by GO Transit or any of its operators, create an inconvenience to the public, or fail to abide by conditions herein set out.

5. GROUP PASS

A Group Pass:

5.1 - may be sold to a group consisting of a maximum of five persons (who are not necessarily related), of whom at least one but not more than two are eighteen years of age or over, except an adult passenger accompanied by more than one Minor (excluding infants under the age of 12 months), shall pay, in addition to his/her own fare, the fare prescribed by subsection 3.1 for each additional Minor.

5.2 - shall be valid from 3:00 am on the date of issue for an unlimited number of rides on the transit system between the zones in the transit corridor for which the pass is issued, where the value of the pass is equal or greater, until 3:00 am on the day after the date of issue;

5.3 - is not transferable;

5.4 - must be retained and produced for inspection;

5.5 - is not valid in conjunction with Children Group Fares; and

5.6 - is not refundable except as provided in Section 22.8.

6. SENIOR CITIZEN FARES

Senior Citizens will be entitled to travel at the Half-Fare rate as shown in the Fare Conversion Table subject to the following conditions:

6.1 - Senior Citizens are persons sixty-five (65) years of age or over at the time the ticket is tendered.

6.2 - Proof of age must be shown at the time the ticket is tendered for service. For example: Health 65 Card or any other reasonable proof of age document.

6.3 - Senior Citizens need not be residents of Canada.

6.4 - Senior Citizens may be asked by a Proper Authority to show proof of age, and therefore must carry reasonable proof of age identification at all times while travelling on the GO Transit system in order for their ticket to be valid.

6.5 - Where more than one Senior Citizen is travelling, refer to Section 1.10 which may apply.

6.6 - Day Pass

A Day Pass:

6.6.1 - shall be sold at a rate of two times the fare that would be payable by a Senior Citizen for a single one-way fare;

6.6.2 - shall be valid from 3:00 am on the date of issue for an unlimited number of rides on the transit system between the zones in the transit corridor for which the pass is issued, where the value of the pass is equal or greater, until 3:00 am on the day after the date of issue;

6.6.3 - is not transferable;

6.6.4 - must be retained and produced for inspection; and

6.6.5 - is not refundable except as provided in Section 22.8.

7. CHILDREN GROUP TICKET

If space is available, a group of twenty (20) or more Children, under thirteen years of age or attending elementary school up to and including Grade 8, may travel on a Group Ticket subject to the following conditions:

7.1 - A rate of Half-Fare for a one-way single trip per Child will be charged.

7.2 - Group Passes are not allowed and will not be accepted as forming any part or in lieu of a Children Group Fare.

7.3 - A group must be accompanied by a sufficient number of adults to provide adequate supervision. Adults accompanying a group will pay the normal adult fare applying between the stations or zones concerned.

7.4 - Each Group Ticket shall be purchased on the day of travel at least fifteen minutes before departure.

7.5 - Children Group Tickets will not be permitted unless GO Transit is given twenty-four hours prior notice and confirms that space will be available.

8. PRESTO FARE CARD

Any PRESTO cardholder who presents a PRESTO fare card for travel on the transit system must comply with the terms and conditions provided in the cardholder agreement for PRESTO users.

9. ACCESSIBILITY

9.1 - Wayfinding Assistance - Whenever a GO Transit employee is on duty at any GO Transit station and a passenger with a disability who has arrived at least 15 minutes prior to his/her departure time requests assistance in finding a bus or train platform, the GO Transit employee will provide or arrange for such requested wayfinding assistance. If a passenger with a disability arrives within 15 minutes of his/her departure time and requests wayfinding assistance, GO Transit staff will make reasonable efforts to provide assistance. In addition to assistance in locating the train or bus on departure, GO staff will provide assistance at transfer points when there is a station attendant on duty.

9.2 - Support Person Tickets - Passengers that require physical assistance during their use of GO Transit services (including physical assistance to board or alight from a bus or train) should be accompanied by a support person capable of aiding such passengers on and off the bus or train and during their use of GO Transit services. If a passenger has a disability that hinders his or her ability to travel alone, the passenger may purchase a Single Ticket or Day Pass, at the rate for that person as set out in the Tariff of Fares or on the Corporation's public website (www.gotransit.com) and may have the ticket or pass endorsed by a Proper Authority as a Support Person Ticket for the carriage of both the passenger and the support person accompanying him or her.

NOTE - A passenger travelling with the aid of a seeing-eye, hearing-ear or special skills dog can still travel with a support person on a Support Person Ticket.

9.3 - Endorsement of "Support Person Ticket" - The regular form ticket or fare card issued for the passenger with a disability will be endorsed with a stamp, sticker or such other indicator as considered appropriate by the Proper Authority to designate the ticket or fare card as a "Support Person Ticket".

9.4 - The Support Person ticket permits the passenger with a disability and support person to travel together on ONE "SUPPORT PERSON TICKET". ONE TICKET ONLY TO BE ISSUED. Once endorsed as a SUPPORT PERSON TICKET, the passenger must be accompanied by the support person.

9.5 - A wheelchair or other remedial conveyance of the passenger with a disability will be permitted provided there is sufficient space to accommodate such articles in a safe manner.

9.6 - Passengers will make a seat available in the designated priority seating area to a passenger with a disability or a physical limitation.

10. REFUSAL TO PAY FARE

Any passenger who refuses to pay the appropriate fare or purchase the appropriate ticket shall be refused transportation.

11. TRAVELLING WITHOUT VALID SCRIPT

A passenger, when requested, shall surrender his or her ticket or Student Identification Card or proof of age (Senior Citizen) to the Proper Authority for inspection and if he or she fails to do so, may be refused passage or may be issued a Notice of Violation of Metrolinx's fare payment rules by a Proper Authority.

Note: It is an offence for a passenger to travel beyond the destination printed, marked, or encoded on his or her ticket.

12. LIMIT OF SCRIPT

12.1 - A single ride ticket is valid if the trip is commenced within 4 hours of issuance.

12.2 - Unless otherwise specifically provided, GO Transit tickets will carry no expiry date. However, GO Transit reserves the right to require that obsolete tickets be exchanged for the current tickets in use.

12.3 - Where there is no direct routing the passenger is required to purchase 2 tickets for the trip.

13. UNDER-RIDES

All tickets may be accepted for a station or zone that is not beyond the station or zone printed or encoded within the corridor where the fare for the changed destination is equal to or less than the fare printed or encoded on the ticket. However, a premium fare may be collected if a downtown bus surcharge is involved.

14. INTERLINE TICKETS

14.1 - Interline tickets are only valid for transportation on GO Transit services if they are exchanged for equivalent value GO Transit media at bus terminals, Union Station or by Bus Drivers.

14.2 - Ameripass or any Excursion Tickets will not be accepted for travel on GO Transit services.

15. STOP-OVER

A ticket is valid only for continuous passage without stop-over, on services scheduled to stop at the destination printed or encoded on the ticket.

16. SPECIAL RATES

Special rates of fare other than regular rates will be effective as published in bulletins, supplements to the Tariff of Fares or as posted on the Corporation's public website (www.go transit.com) from time to time.

17. METHOD OF PAYMENT**17.1 - Cash Transactions:**

17.1.1 - except as otherwise provided, fares are payable in cash and in Canadian funds or U.S. funds.

17.1.2 - only transactions involving bills of \$20.00 or less will be accepted by Bus Drivers.

17.2 - Traveller's Cheques:

17.2.1 - are payable in Canadian or U.S. funds (at a rate established by GO Transit) and only acceptable for the purchase of GO Transit ticket at most stations, terminals, and agencies;

17.2.2 - must be made payable to GO Transit;

17.2.3 - must be endorsed in the presence of the ticket agent or seller, and the signature must agree with the other signature on the cheque;

17.2.4 - identification must be produced - driver's licence, credit card (with signature), etc.;

17.2.5 - will NOT be converted to cash.

17.3 - Credit and Debit Cards:

17.3.1 - Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Debit Card services are available at GO Stations, Yorkdale, York Mills, Newmarket, Union, Hamilton Bus Terminals and participating agencies. Finch Terminal and York University agency accept Visa and MasterCard only.

17.4 - Transportation Warrants:

17.4.1 - must bear an authorizing signature from the group or organization issuing the warrant;

17.4.2 - will not be accepted if they have been visibly altered or changed in any way.

17.4.3 - GO Transit will not give out funds for any meal allowances identified on transportation warrants.

17.5 - U.S. Funds:

17.5.1 - are acceptable for the purchase of tickets at all stations and terminals and on buses;

17.5.2 - exchange will be made when transportation is sold at a rate established by GO Transit's Revenue Accounting Office;

17.5.3 - coin will be accepted only at par.

18. SEASONAL OPERATION

18.1 - Operation of certain services as well as certain frequencies of service are seasonal in character.

18.2 - GO Transit reserves the right to issue or honour a ticket only during the season that service is operated.

19. AGENTS' DUTIES

Agents and employees of GO Transit cannot deviate from the Tariff rates or subsequent amendments thereto, sale dates, and the rules and conditions shown herein.

20. INSPECTION OF TICKETS, PASSES AND STUDENT ID CARDS

20.1 - A passenger, when requested, shall surrender for inspection his or her ticket or Student Identification Card to the Proper Authority.

20.1.1 - Any ticket remains the property of GO Transit and is subject to confiscation without refund if the holder violates any conditions of its use.

20.2 - No person shall enter the transit system without activating the device to validate the intended trip unless:

20.2.1 - The person enters the transit system at a location where a cash fare may be paid and that person pays the appropriate fare; or

20.2.2 - The person has a ticket that is not intended to be validated.

20.3 - No person shall travel or attempt to travel on the transit system without paying the appropriate fare.

20.4 - Where the amount of the fare charged for passage is disputed, the driver, station attendant, or agent shall support the fare by reference to the Metrolinx Tariff of Fares. In the event that the passenger is still not satisfied, he or she should pay the fare requested and send complete details to GO Transit:

20.5 - A person shall not enter or leave a station or station grounds except at designated entrances or exits.

21. LOST, MISPLACED OR STOLEN SCRIPT

GO Transit or its operators are not responsible to patrons for lost, misplaced or stolen tickets, which will NOT be replaced or refunded.

22. REFUNDS

22.1 - Up to \$50.00 of the unused value loaded on any PRESTO card may be presented to a station attendant for a cash refund; provided that an administrative fee equal to 4% of the total value of the refund will apply.

22.2 - As a general rule, GO Transit does not offer refunds for paper tickets; however, unless the pass specifically states otherwise, advance sale Group Passes, Day Passes or Special Event Passes may be refunded at full value if presented to a station attendant for refund before the date printed on the face of the pass. Please see also “GO Service Guarantee” in Section 23 below.

23. GO SERVICE GUARANTEE

23.1 - Certain delayed trips may be eligible for a credit under the GO Service Guarantee. Information about the GO Service Guarantee is available on the Corporation’s public website at www.gotransit.com.

24. CLAIMS

24.1 - GO Transit and its operators are not liable for delays caused by accidents, road or track condition, snow storms, or other conditions beyond their control or for failure to depart from or arrive at any point, station, or destination at the time shown in timetables published by GO Transit.

24.2 - GO Transit and its operators are not responsible for loss or damage to property on GO Transit property, including trains or buses.

24.3 - Any claims of whatever character must be filed in writing within twenty-four (24) hours to:

25. LOST AND FOUND

25.1 - GO Transit or its operators will not assume responsibility for lost property on GO Transit property, including trains or buses.

25.2 - For items lost on GO Transit property, including trains and buses, passengers should contact:

25.3 - A Passenger must allow for up to 48 hours processing time involved for items to arrive at Lost and Found.

26. RIGHTS RESERVED

26.1 - Refusal of Passage

A Proper Authority may refuse passage on a transit system operated by or for GO Transit to:

26.1.1 - a person in possession of explosives, a firearm, a dangerous weapon, flammable material, or any other dangerous thing or material;

26.1.2 - a person under the influence of drugs or alcohol;

26.1.3 - a person whose conduct is or is likely to be objectionable to other passengers;

26.1.4 - a person carrying hand luggage, a parcel, or any object or thing that does inconvenience or is likely to inconvenience other passengers.

26.1.5 - a person who fails to comply with the instructions of a Proper Authority.

26.1.6 - if a person has purchased a ticket and has been refused passage by a Proper Authority on a transit system operated by or for GO for any of the reasons described above in this section 26.1, the person may request a refund from the station attendant.

26.2 - Stops

26.2.1 - Trains and buses shall be required to make stops only as provided by the timetables established by GO Transit except for accidents, road or track conditions, snow storms, or other conditions beyond their control or where for reasons of safety an alternate stopping place is required.

26.2.2 - In rural areas, where there are significant distances between bus stops, buses may stop when “flagged down” by a passenger, where safe operations and due consideration for other traffic on the road make it practical to do so. If it is not safe or practical to make frequent stops in close proximity, passengers may be requested to use a reasonable common location.

26.2.3 - After dusk, a passenger deboarding from a bus may request the driver to stop at a location other than an established bus stop, where it is safe and practical to do so. For safety and operational reasons, passengers may be requested to use a reasonable common location if a number of passengers make a request for stop in close proximity.

26.3 - Transferring Passengers

GO Transit and its operators shall have the right wherever operating circumstances require it, to transfer passengers from one train or one bus to another, or combination of both.

26.4 - Schedule Revisions

GO Transit reserves the right to modify schedules without notice.

26.5 - Capacity

GO Transit does not guarantee sufficient capacity on any train or bus to accommodate any or all passengers.

26.6 - Seating

GO Transit reserves full control and discretion as to seating of passengers and the right to change such seating should it be deemed necessary at any time during the trip, provided that seating arrangements will be made without regard to race, colour, sex, creed, national origin or other prohibited ground of discrimination described in Section 1 of the Ontario Human Rights Code, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.19.

A Proper Authority will make every effort to locate a seat in the designated priority seating area to accommodate a person who is disabled or has a physical limitation.

26.7 - Parking Lots

GO Transit will not assume responsibility for damage to or loss of property within its parking lots. Persons leaving their vehicles do so at their own risk. GO Transit does not guarantee sufficient capacity at any parking lot to accommodate any or all vehicles. Parking is provided on a first-come, first-served basis at locations where parking is available, except locations where reserved parking is available and a reserved parking spot has been purchased.

27. SMOKING

Smoking is NOT permitted on GO Transit property, except in exterior parking areas or other locations specifically designated and signed as smoking areas.

28. ANIMALS

No person shall bring an animal on the transit system unless it is in an enclosed container that must be secured and does not inconvenience other passengers. This section does not apply to sight-guide dogs, hearing-ear dogs or special-skills dogs with disabled passengers, or a trainer of a skills dog.

29. STATIONS, TERMINALS, VEHICLES AND PARKING LOTS

29.1 - No person shall enter or leave a station or station grounds or other facilities of the GO Transit System except through a designated entrance or exit as the case may be.

29.2 - No person shall distribute, place and post handbills, signs, notices or any other form of written or printed material on or within any facility of GO Transit without prior written permission from a Proper Authority.

29.3 - No person shall litter or deposit any waste on GO Transit property except in designated waste facilities.

29.4 - Nothing in this section shall prohibit the posting of signs, official notices and information by GO Transit.

29.5 - No person shall loiter or linger without due cause on GO Transit property.

29.6 - No person shall sell or attempt to sell any merchandise, article or other thing or solicit members of the public for any purpose in any facility of GO Transit without the prior written permission of GO Transit.

29.7 - No person shall operate a motor vehicle on the Corporation's property:

29.7.1 - except upon roadways, parking areas or any other areas designated for use by motor vehicles;

29.7.2 - unless it is incidental to the use of the system by the driver or a passenger of the vehicle.

29.7.3 - at a speed in excess of twenty-five (25) kilometres per hour unless otherwise posted.

29.7.4 - if it is unlicensed, unregistered or unplatd.

29.8 - No person shall park a vehicle within a GO Transit parking lot:

29.8.1 - except in a designated parking space;

29.8.2 - for a period of more than forty-eight (48) hours.

29.8.3 - if the gross weight of the vehicle exceeds 4,536 kilograms or 10,000 pounds.

29.8.4 - in a designated area marked as 'reserved' unless the vehicle or class of vehicles is registered to do so;

29.8.5 - in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic or otherwise prevent the safe removal of any other vehicle previously parked or left standing, and

29.8.6 - occupy more than one designated spot at a time.

29.9 - No person shall park, stand, or stop a vehicle:

29.9.1 - in an area designated for parking for persons with a disability unless a valid disabled person parking permit is displayed on the vehicle.

29.9.2 - within GO Transit's property except in an area designated for parking, standing, or stopping as the case may be.

29.9.3 - in an area designated as a fire route or for use of emergency vehicles only.

29.10 - No person shall do any act in contravention of instructions or directions indicated on any sign erected on GO Transit property.

29.11 - No person shall roller-skate, in-line skate or skate-board on GO Transit property.

29.12 - No person shall wear roller-skates or in-line skates while in a train or other vehicle operated by GO Transit.

29.13 - No person shall operate a bicycle, tricycle or unicycle on GO Transit property except on a roadway for the purpose of arriving at or departing from a GO Transit station or terminal.

29.14 - No person shall cross any railway tracks on GO Transit property or property used to provide GO Transit service except where specifically designated for pedestrian crossing, and no person shall attempt to cross any railway crossing when the crossing warning signals have been activated.

29.15 - No person shall operate for commercial purposes any camera, video recording device, movie camera or any similar device upon the transit system without the express written permission of GO Transit.

29.16 - No person shall, without authorization, operate any radio, tape recorder, musical instrument, or similar device in or upon any vehicle or premises of GO Transit unless the sound therefrom is conveyed to that person by an earphone at a sound level that does not disturb other passengers.

29.17 - No person shall expectorate in or upon any vehicle or premises of GO Transit, or urinate or defecate on GO Transit property except in facilities intended for such activities.

29.18 - No person shall place himself or herself in a position or perform an action likely to interfere with the operator of a GO Transit vehicle having proper control of the vehicle or likely to obstruct the vision of the operator.

29.19 - No person shall, without authorization, handle or operate any part of the mechanical, electrical or electronic equipment of any vehicle or any part of the transit system operated by GO Transit except devices which are intended for passenger use, and then only in accordance with posted instructions.

29.20 - No person shall interfere with or activate the passenger assistance alarm devices on GO Transit's vehicles or property without reasonable cause.

29.21 - No person shall (i) use profane, insulting or obscene language, (ii) behave in an indecent or offensive manner, (iii) fight, or (iv) interfere with the ordinary enjoyment of the transit system while on GO Transit vehicles or property.

29.22 - Every person shall remain behind the platform safety markings until it is safe to enter or leave the train or bus.

30. BAGGAGE

Facilities for checking of transported baggage are not provided at rail or bus stations or on buses or trains. Passengers travelling on GO Transit Service shall be limited to luggage, parcels, or objects which they can carry and which will not cause any inconvenience to other passengers. Folded baby strollers and folded bicycles only will be permitted on buses when there is sufficient space to accommodate such articles. Skis and poles and other large baggage may also be permitted but only when there is sufficient space to accommodate such articles.

Note: For the purpose of this Rule, a folded bicycle means a collapsible bicycle which is designed to fold with a hinge and be reduced to a size not exceeding 80 cm. x 80 cm. x 30 cm., and carried in a proper carrying case such as canvas, leather, wood, or other substantial material.

31. BICYCLES ON TRAINS

Wherever the word “bicycle” is used it will include tricycles and unicycles.

31.1 - No person shall bring or attempt to bring a bicycle into the GO Transit owned areas in Union Station between 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., and 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, and no person shall bring or attempt to bring a bicycle onto a GO train that is scheduled to:

31.1.1 - stops at Union Station between 6:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m., Monday through Friday,
or

31.1.2 - stops at Union Station between 3:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

31.1.A - This restriction applies regardless of whether the person’s origin or destination includes Union Station.

31.2 - This prohibition does not apply on statutory holidays.

31.3 - Bicycles (or other large objects) exceeding 173 cm. (68”) in length and 41 cm. (16”) in width will not be carried on a train.

31.4 - No more than two bicycles may be transported in each vestibule of a rail car and bicycles are prohibited in cars designated as accessible to disabled persons.

31.5 - A Proper Authority may refuse passage to any person transporting a bicycle:

31.5.1 - during an emergency (in which case bicycles are to be left on board the train); and

31.5.2 - at any time trains are heavily loaded and the introduction of a bicycle is deemed unsafe.

32. DRIVER ASSISTANCE

When sufficient space is available, Bus Drivers shall assist passengers by loading/unloading baggage into/from the underfloor compartment on buses so equipped, or by carrying baggage into/from the bus interior. For the purpose of this section, baggage will include such articles as wheelchairs and remedial conveyances, strollers, folding bicycles, etc.

33. PAYMENT OF PARKING INFRACTION NOTICES OR NOTICES OF VIOLATION

33.1 - Parking Infraction Notices or Notices of Violation issued by a Proper Authority are payable within fifteen (15) days of the issue date. Payments can be made:

33.1.3 - by credit card (Visa, American Express or MasterCard) at:

33.1.4 - Cheques returned as insufficient funds may be subject to an administrative charge or fee established by GO Transit and/or forwarded to a third party for collection.

33.1.5 - GO Transit reserves the right to accept or refuse payments made in disposition of a Parking Infraction Notice or Notice of Violation.

33.2 - Requests to review a Parking Infraction Notice or Notice of Violation may be made by telephone at (416) 869-3600 ext. 7180, by written submission to the address as shown above or by email - ComplianceServices@gotransit.com

33.2.1 - The Administrative Reviewer reserves the right to vary, modify, adjust, amend or withdraw the Parking Infraction Notice or Notice of Violation.

33.2.2. - A request for administrative review for a Parking Infraction Notice shall not be accepted after forty-five (45) days following the date of offence.

33.2.3. - If a Parking Infraction Notice or Notice of Violation is unresolved following the administrative review process, an individual is entitled to commence further proceedings as outlined on the particular notice.

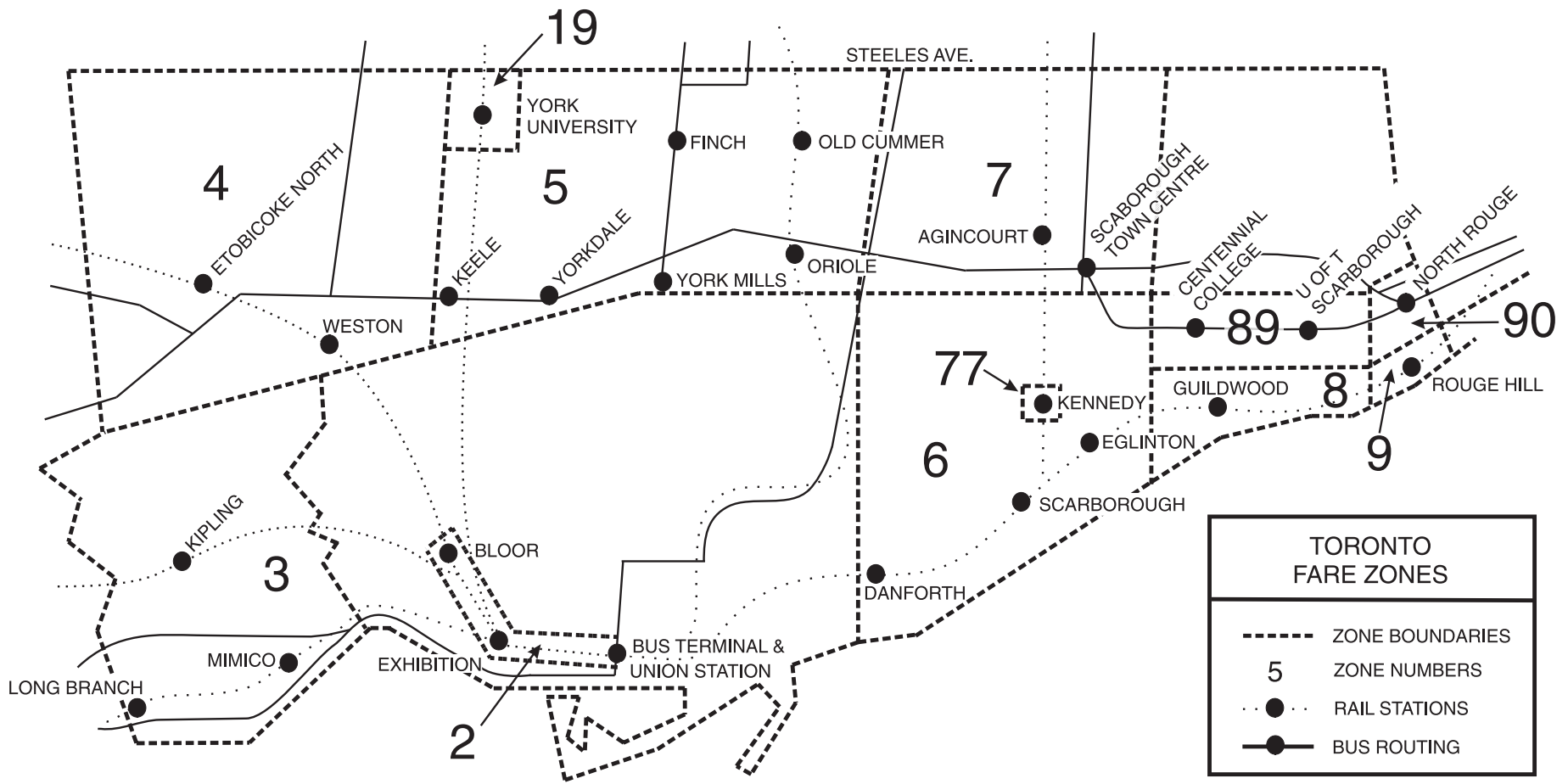

Tariff of Fares
(Effective September 2, 2017)

1. This Tariff of Fares shall be maintained at the head office of the Corporation, 97 Street West, Toronto, and shall be available for public review during the regular business hours of the Corporation.
2. This Tariff of Fares sets out the fares applicable for a single ride for an Adult or a Child/Senior, as defined herein, including all applicable taxes.
3. Passengers who use a PRESTO card to pay for their fares will receive a discount from the amount set out on this Tariff of Fares. Details of this and other applicable discounts are available online at www.gotransit.com.
4. When a passenger travels on the transit system from a point outside the City of Toronto to another point outside the City of Toronto, and can only do so by travelling through the City of Toronto by means of more than one transit service provided by the Corporation, the following rules apply in determining the total fare payable:
 - (a) If there is more than one transit service available between the passenger’s point of departure and the City of Toronto or between the City of Toronto and the passenger’s destination point, the fare payable for each transit service shall be the lowest fare available for the trip, regardless of which transit service the passenger actually takes.

¹ The Adult single fare applies to any passenger thirteen (13) years of age or older.
