

## BY-LAW NO. 12

A by-law relating  
to certain joint operations of

### **Greater Toronto Transit Authority**

#### WHEREAS:

- A. Section 14 of the By-law No. 2 allows the Authority to provide discounted marketing programs in order to encourage commuter ridership.
- B. The Authority and VIA Rail Canada Inc. ("VIA") wish to provide increased commuter services on the Lakeshore and Georgetown rail corridors in the area of jurisdiction of the Authority by cooperating in the provision of joint services (the "Joint Services") utilizing certain of VIA's intercity services and facilities.
- C. The efficient provision of the Joint Services requires the harmonization of certain operating terms and conditions and fares.
- D. The Joint Services are being provided on a trial basis in order to determine its marketing and business development potential.
- E. On the demonstration of the success of the Joint Services program following a trial period, the Authority shall provide for any permanent arrangements to be implemented in accordance with the *GO Transit Act, 2001*.

BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of Greater Toronto Transit Authority (the "Authority") as follows:

- 1. For the purposes of the Joint Services between the Authority and VIA only, the definition of "adult" otherwise referred to in By-law No. 2 is a person between the ages of 12 and 59, inclusive, a "child" is a person between the ages of 2 and 11, inclusive, and a "senior citizen" is a person 60 years of age or older.
- 2. For passengers traveling on VIA rail service and connecting to the Authority's transit service as part of the Joint Service, such passengers must be in possession of a valid VIA ticket and a valid single-ride ticket of the Authority, issued by VIA at the point of origin of the trip. Transfers between VIA trains and

the Authority's transit system, including trains, train-buses and train-meet buses, can only be made at Union Station in Toronto.

3. For Authority patrons using VIA rail services as part of the Joint Services, such passengers must be in possession of a valid 10-Ride Ticket or Monthly Pass issued by the Authority, and a "GO VIA Pak" of 10 detachable single-ride coupons, issued by VIA, to travel aboard VIA trains between jointly operated train stations on the Lakeshore and Georgetown rail corridors.
4. Goods and Services Tax is applicable on all services provided as part of the Joint Services.

The foregoing restated By-law No. 12 is hereby consented to and passed by the Members of the Authority, this 18th day of January, 2002, pursuant to Subsection 11(1) of the *GO Transit Act, 2001*.
