

## **BY-LAW NO. 4**

A by-law relating  
to the appointment of provincial offences officers of

### **Greater Toronto Transit Authority**

BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of Greater Toronto Transit Authority (the "Authority") as follows:

1. All previous by-laws of the Authority and any amendments thereto relating to the subject matter of this by-law, including those by-laws and regulations relating to the subject matter hereto deemed by section 33(3) of the *GO Transit Act, 2001* (Ontario) (the "*GO Transit Act*") to have been passed as a by-law of the Authority are repealed and the by-laws contained herein shall become the by-laws of the Authority for the subject matter contained herein.
2. The persons set out in Schedule "A" hereto, representing the Manager, Transit Enforcement and all current Transit Enforcement Supervisors, Transit Enforcement Officers, Customer Attendants and Prosecutors employed by the Authority, are hereby appointed as officers of the Authority pursuant to Subsection 11(6) of the *GO Transit Act*, for the purpose of enforcing the by-laws of the Authority passed under the authority of Subsection 11(1) of the *GO Transit Act*.
3. The appointments in Section 2 hereof shall take effect on the date hereof.
4. The Authority may appoint further officers and remove those officers whose duties no longer require such appointment by further by-laws amending Schedule "A" hereto.
5. The Authority may request in writing to the Minister of Transportation that any of the officers of the Authority designated in Schedule "A", as amended from time to time, be appointed as provincial offences officers for the purposes of the *Provincial Offences Act*, either individually or by class, and such appointment shall take effect on the date so designated by the Minister of Transportation.
6. The Authority may request in writing to the Commissioner of the Ontario Provincial Police that any of the officers of the Authority designated in Schedule "A", as amended from time to time, and identified as Transit Enforcement Officers, may be appointed as Special Constables pursuant to the *Police*

*Services Act*, and such appointment shall take effect on the date so designated by the Commissioner of the Ontario Provincial Police.

The foregoing restated By-law No. 4 is hereby consented to and passed by the Members of the Authority, this 18th day of January, 2002, pursuant to Subsection 11(6) of the *GO Transit Act*.
