



TRANSFORMING TRANSIT IN YOUR AREA

Union Station Rail Corridor Signal Modernization

Signals are the stoplights of the train network. A modernized system will reduce signal disruptions, improve reliability and allow trains to move faster, while maintaining Metrolinx's high safety standards. An improved signal system will allow for faster recovery from train delays or equipment problems and will be designed for increased train speeds.

THE LOCAL PROJECT

We are completing conduit installation for signal upgrades in the Union Station Rail Corridor from **Simcoe Street to Scott Street**. Work is scheduled to take place overnight between **Monday October 23 and Monday October 30** from the hours of 20:00 to 5:00 am.

WHAT TO EXPECT

We recognize that this work can be disruptive to residents and we are doing our best to carry out this essential construction with the least disruption possible.

Tracks must be taken out of service to complete this work and as a result this work can only be carried out during off-peak times, when there is less train traffic. Nearby residents may notice some activity from power tools and equipment movement during this time.
