Union Station Rail Corridor Switch Modernization

Switches enable trains to be guided from one track to another. A modernized switch system will improve the reliability of service by allowing trains to move through the Union Station Rail Corridor at faster speeds, providing a more seamless passage through Canada's busiest rail corridor, while maintaining GO Transit's high safety standards.

THE LOCAL PROJECT

We are installing, testing, and commissioning switches in the Union Station Rail Corridor between Union Station and Scott Street. Work is scheduled to take place continuously from **Friday July 21 through to Monday July 24** between the hours of **8 p.m. and 6 a.m.**

WHAT TO EXPECT

We recognize that this work can be disruptive to residents and we are doing our best to carry out this essential construction with the least disruption possible.

Tracks must be taken out of service to complete this work and as a result this work can only be carried out during off-peak times, when there is less train traffic. Nearby residents may notice some activity from power tools and equipment movement during this time.
