Construction Activity Update: Vacuum Truck Between Cherry Street and the Don River

Metrolinx is committed to updating our neighbours along the Union Station Rail Corridor (USRC), and we are writing to provide you with information regarding some upcoming maintenance work.

THE LOCAL PROJECT

Through the week, Metrolinx will be using a vacuum truck for excavation between **Cherry Street and the Don River**. This work is being done to acquire vital buried utilities information required for future work in this area.

Work is scheduled to take place **continuously** starting **Monday July 24 to Saturday July 29**.

Due to the nature of this work, this is the only method of excavating that can be used without damaging live underground services. **Please note:** For the purposes of safety, work times are subject to appropriate weather conditions.

WHAT TO EXPECT

We recognize that this work can be disruptive to residents and we are doing our best to carry out this essential construction with the least disruption possible.

Tracks must be taken out of service to complete this work and as a result this work can only be carried out during off-peak times, when there is less train traffic. Nearby residents may notice some activity from power tools and equipment movement during this time.
