Construction Activity Update: Tower Crane Installation

GO Transit is committed to updating our neighbours in the Union Station area. We are writing to inform you about some upcoming Union Station Revitalization construction.

As part of GO Transit's Train Shed Revitalization, a large tower crane will be installed on August 12 – 15, 2011. The work is scheduled to start at 8:00 p.m. Friday and last until approximately 4:00 a.m. on Monday. The installation process, including materials delivery will take place in the train corridor and we expect that the process will have little disruption to our neighbours. Once in place, the crane will rise high above the train shed and will help facilitate the restoration of the roof and the installation of the new large glass atrium.

The tower crane will be in place for the duration of the train shed restoration period with completion scheduled for in 2015. Its presence will be mostly visual as it will be anchored below the surface of Union Station, rising through the VIA concourse and GO Train platform level and through the top of the existing train shed roof.

GO is completely restoring the train shed roof in a revitalization effort that combines the modern technology of the atrium with respect for the historical and heritage significance of this landmark building.
